At regionals should there be a time for members to address the national rep other than the breakfast or banquet, if there are educationals how many, should there be workshops at regionals, should they be 2 days, is it required to have sponsorship from more than one chapter and other items brought up by the committee.

The committee would consist of three board members, two members of the convention committee and two members from the membership at large.
